



Step 1: Create a new dashboard

Launch the AUDAC Touch™ 2 app an log in. Once you have logged in you can select 'Create a Dashboard' to start.




# Step 2: Start adding widgets

In the top right corner, you can tap 'Edit Dashboard'. After this the button 'Add widget' will activate. Tap this button and a selection menu 'add widget' will appear.




## Step 3: Add a widget

Choose the device type of audio matrix that you have in your installation. Select the correct device in case you have multiple devices of the same type in your network. Finally choose the widget you want to add. In this example we will be using 'Zone slider' An extra element will appear where you can select the correct output number. Repeat this process until you have added all outputs you want to control in your Dashboard.




## **Step 4: Overview widget**

The result will look like the example underneath. You will notice that by choosing the 'Zone slider' we not only have added a volume slider but also a name label, mute button and input selection for each zone.



# **Step 5: Rearrange widgets.**

You can now rearrange all widgets by adding more panels and simply drag and drop each widget to your preferred size. All widgets are freely scalable and placeable so you can fully customize the dashboard to your own liking. After you are finished you can go ahead and select 'Edit Dashboard' and then 'Save' in the top right corner.



## Step 6: Result Dashboard

After you have saved you will see that the result is an identical copy of the web interface that you are accustomed to. You can now go ahead and control the device.



# Step 7: Result Dashboard

In case you don't want users of the app to make changes to the dashboard? Then you can tap on 'Lock'. Here you can choose and set a pin code for this Dashboard. Users of the device can then only use the functionalities of this patticular Dashboard but cannot make any changes to the settings.

As an admin at any time you can simply unlock the dashboard and do necessary changes if needed.
